Western Australia		<p>Traveling resource sector workers will need to complete an arrival form and confirm "Essential Traveller" status by selecting "Specialist skills" CME report - but not officially announced. Queensland		<p>Those living outside of Queensland who provide critical services to Queensland, may be exempt to self-quarantine.
